If approved, the bonds will fund \$300 million of the nearly \$1 billion priority facility improvements for Orange County Schools and Chapel Hill Carrboro City Schools over the next 15 years.

The projected cost of the bonds is \$34.10 per \$100,000 of assessed property value.

Fact:

If bonds are not approved, the county will rely on traditional borrowing methods, limiting school facility improvements.
